- Coordinated stakeholder meeting with the Arizona State Land Department and provided formal comments on numerous rule changes affecting land uses.
- Participated in a fundraising event to support Congressman
 Juan Ciscomani in his upcoming re-election campaign.
- Successfully advocated for the Town of Sahuarita to streamline processes for installing sidewalks and minimizing fees for two sidewalk inspections.

MAY

JUNE

- Collaborated with Tucson Chief Building Officials to implement a policy allowing the Registrant of Record to expedite deferred submittals by conducting peer reviews of engineered truss system documentation for permitted buildings.



JULY

- Over 125 members took a break from the heat for the Summer Mixer sponsored by Beasley, Mitchel & Co. at the cool Arizona Sands Club.
- Fresh off his re-election to a second term, Oro Valley Mayor Joe Winfield, joined by City Manager Jeff Wilkes, attended a "Coffee With" meeting for SAHBA members.
- Following an in-depth process, the SAHBA-PAC wrapped **up candidate evaluations** and announced endorsements for the Primary Election.
- The SAHBA Remodeler's Council hosted Brian Hudson, **ADOSH Director**, for a Q&A session on OSHA updates, emphasizing heat safety, fall protection, and maintaining safety standards in remodeling projects.
- Mitigated the cost impacts of an increase in the Tucson Planning & Development Services fee schedule by securing a multi-year phased-in approach.







AUGUST

- Home builders in Marana connected with the Town's Chief Building Official, Dave Spurlock at a Builder Roundtable to discuss permitting, building codes and inspections.
- The Pima County Board of Supervisors approved a **heat** ordinance for county and contracted workers, which SAHBA helped ensure did not extend to the private sector, while also participating in discussions on OSHA's proposed Heat Standard with the Home Builders Association of Central Arizona and NAHB.
- Hosted a meeting with Tucson's Planning and **Development Services Department** to discuss updates, improvements, and challenges in permit processing and inspections.
- Partnered with the Coalition for Sonoran Desert Protection **on a welcome reception** for Kris Gade, newly hired Director of Pima County Conservation Lands & Resources Department and Tracy Peterson, newly hired Deputy Director of Pima County Development Services Department.



SEPTEMBER

- Held yet another wildly successful Annual Charity Golf Classic with 288 golfers participating in this sold-out event of fun, networking, and raising funds for student scholarships.
- SAHBA members gathered for hors d'oeuvres, drinks, and making connections for the Fall Mixer sponsored by Arizona Appliance & Home and LG.
- City of Tucson Chief Building Official, Juan Garcia, joined representatives from Tucson's leading builders for a Builder Roundtable to talk about Tucson Development Center online portal, the International I-Code update and other key issues.
- For the fourth consecutive year, the **Pima Co. Development** Services Department fee schedule was reduced by 5% as the result of a reserve policy that SAHBA developed with the Department.









OCTOBER

- SAHBA-PAC wrapped up candidate evaluation process and announced endorsements for the 2024 General Election.

- Facilitated an **interactive discussion** with builder members and David Laws (Permitting Manager), Larry Merrill (Building Official) from the Town of Oro Valley.
- Hosted a Lunch & Learn featuring Lisa Nutt with the Tucson Association of Realtors to brief members on the NAR Compensation Settlement agreement.
- During a campaign break, Congressman Eli Crane met with SAHBA members to discuss home building and his initiatives in Washington, D.C.
- Participated in the NAHB Fall Leadership meeting in San Antonio.



NOVEMBER

- The 2024 Cornhole Tournament, presented by J.R. McDade, expanded from 30 to 42 teams competing to be the "Boss of the Toss".
